Shaheen Group of Institutions; Bidar, Karnataka hosted two days of All India Education Summit on 1st and 2nd December 2021 to connect Huffaz, Ulama and dropouts to mainstream education. Promotion and strengthening of open school programme in Madrasas, Reforms in Madrasa Curriculum and Pattern, Academic Intensive Care Unit (AICU - Shaheen Model), Minority Education Issues, and Dropout Prevention Programmes were the major themes of the summit.

Dr Abdul Qadeer, Shaheen Group of Institutions' Chairman, in his electrifying opening words, iterated on following the government's Covid guidelines by organizing the summit in virtual mode with minimal participants at the venue. He recounted the inception and extensive evolution of Shaheen Group by illustrating students' academic excellence irrespective of cast, creed, class and religion. He narrated the success stories of AICU students. He concluded his words by emphasizing on vitality of Academic Intensive Care Units across the nation to connect Huffaz, Ulama and dropouts to mainstream education.

Moulana Shafi Saadi, Chairman of Waqf Board Karnataka highlighted the need for rejuvenation in Madrasa system in his guest address. He stressed upon the need of ample number of lawyers and government employees from the Muslim community in Karnataka. He intended to utilize Waqf land in Bidar for establishing educational institutions. He cited the Quran's verses pertinent to modern education.

Speaking to the gatherings in his guest address, Moulana Azhar Hussain, member of Waqf Board Karnataka, said that the education should be prioritized to sustain humanity in the world. He continued to say that education and knowledge are the most powerful tools for positively driving the Muslim community.



Renowned educationist and social worker from Alipur, Dr Ahmed Abbas, delivered the last guest address of the inaugural programme of All India Education Summit – 2021. In his speech, he emphasized on protecting Islam from evil powers or forces. He urged the well-wishers to financially contribute to the education of needy Muslims.

The afternoon session of the day commenced with the paper presentation of Hamza Mauzam Ali, CEO of Standard Touch, on growing importance of technology in educational institutions. He spoke about technologically embedded hybrid educational model based on Learning Management System (LMS). He insisted upon the high relevance of LMS pertinent to Artificial Intelligent (AI) and Machine Learning in the epoch of pandemic.





The last session of the day was culminated with the inspiring story of business tycoon Janab Ziaulla Shareef from India Builders Corporation. The session was moderated by Syed Tanveer Ahmed, Director of Shaheen Academy of Foundation Education. Janab Ziaulla advised the audience to make Allah as their best friend. "Medicine in the hands of a foolish is poison such as poison becomes medicine in the hands of wise", he exclaimed.



The first session of the second day of the summit took off with presentation on role of Madrasa, schools and colleges in career guidance - post covid -19 by Ameen E Mudassar, Founder and CEO of CIGMA Foundation. He proposed integrated wholistic education mission for the betterment of minority education.



Talking to the audience on keys to unlock the educational excellence, Sameer Siddiqui, IAS coach and motivational speaker, highlighted the need of updating Madrasa students with current affairs and artificial intelligence. According to him, entrepreneurship must flourish to protect madrasa value system.

Professor Ashfaq Ahmad, Head of the Department of Arabic Studies, Banaras Hindu University, who has initiated admission of Madrasa students in the university this year, spoke on career prospects for a Madrasa student. He insisted on revamping Madrasas which are at the verge of closing.




